1. \$20 1870, Fr. 1152, **National Gold Bank Note-San Fran.** Ch#1741 A tangible link to the wild west and the Calif. gold rush, but also to the most formative stages of American currency. Comments of repaired and trimmed mentioned on back has been executed with consummate skill to stabilize this historic banknote for future generations. Ask for high-res scans. PMG VG 10, net.\$15,950



2. \$100 1922 GC, Fr. 1215, **Benton.** Bright paper, lovely gold underprint with rich red seal and bright blue serials. Back is vibrant and note presents very attractively. PMG VF 30.\$3250

3. \$100 1882 GC, Fr. 1210, **Department Series.** Clean + lovely dept. series hundred with great eye-appeal. PMG VF 20.\$3295

4. \$10 1922 Fr. 1173am, **Gold Cert.** Hillegas at center with incredible and vibrant orange ink on both sides. Mule with small serial numbers. PCGS-B Ch VF 35.\$635



5. \$20 1922 **Gold Cert.** Bright paper, vibrant back, comment free. PMG VF 30.\$550

6. \$20 1922 **Gold Cert.** Almost as nice as above, still comment free. PMG VF 25.\$445

7. \$20 1922 **Gold Cert.** Bright back, no comment. PMG VF 20.\$415

8. \$1 1886 SC, Fr. 219, **Martha.** Ornate back with large brown spiked seal and comment of 'small tear' that's well-concealed in the margin and doesn't enter the design. PMG Abt Unc 55.\$1995

9. \$2 1891 SC, Fr. 246, **Window.** An attractive mid-grade Window with no negative comments. PMG VF 20.\$995



10. \$5 1899 SC, Fr. 281m, **Chief.** Bright, original, and iconic. Only 4% of Fr. 281s graded 30 have the EPQ/PPQ designation. VF 30EPQ.\$1895

11. \$5 1899 SC, Fr. 275, **Chief.** A stunning example of an iconic note preserved in an attractive and affordable condition. PMG VF 30.\$1750



12. \$50 1869 LT, Fr. 151, **Rainbow.** Henry Clay at right. Gorgeous color for the grade with some soiling and seemingly invisible restorations. PMG Fine 12, net.\$18,950



13. \$20 1869 LT, Fr. 127, **Scarce Rainbow.** PMG notes restoration + after studying both sides, we're simply unable to locate any trace of this accusation. Of the 207 serial numbers recorded there's; only around a dozen VF + XF; as such, the opportunities to acquire an affordable example are quite limited. Great color remains. PMG VF 25.\$6995

14. \$1 1869 LT, Fr. 18, **Rainbow.** Absolutely stunning colors on this mid-grade one-year design. PMG VF 30.\$1795

15. \$2 1918 FRBN, Fr. 772, **Battleship-Minneapolis.** A dynamite deuce with nice eye-appeal for the grade. PMG Ch Fine 15.\$675

16. \$5 1923 SC, **Porthole.** Abraham Lincoln in giant portrait oval with blue seal and serials. Two small paper pulls on the back and a few margin nicks consistent with grade. VF.\$1150

17. \$10 1923 LT, Fr. 123, **Pokerchip.** Brand new to our inventory and an attractive example of an iconic design. Rich red X, seal, and serials. VF.\$2995

18. \$10 1923 LT, Fr. 123, **Pokerchip.** These can quickly get out of reach in higher grades. This one has had a little cosmetic improvement ('minor repairs') which allows a collector to secure an attractive example. PMG VF 20.\$2895



19. \$10 1901 LT, Fr. 122, **Bison.** Fully-original, mid-grade note that has a beautiful black bison positioned between Lewis + Clark. PMG VF 25EPQ. ...\$1895

20. \$10 1901 LT, Fr. 122, **Bison.** Attractive example that just arrived and didn't have time for grading. Get it cheap. VF.\$1125

21. \$10 1901 LT, Fr. 122, **Bison.** Speelman-White with comment of 'small edge split' along fold line. PCGS-B Fine 12.\$925

22. \$10 1901 LT, Fr. 116, **Bison.** Vernon-Treat sigs appear on this comment-free note. PMG Fine 12.\$995



23. \$1 1880 USN, Fr. 30, **Cut Sheet.** Four well preserved consecutive notes. An ideal trophy to be kept together or sold individually for an immediate profit. Deep embossing, bright seal and bold overprint highlight each of these. Three notes grade PMG Ch Unc 63 with the comment "good embossing", the first grades PMG Ch Unc 63EPQ with comments "exceptional paper quality and embossing." A monumental offering.\$6295



24. \$1 1923 USN, Fr. 40, **Cut Sheet.** Wonderful opportunity for the collector seeking the unusual or the dealer for individual resale. Notes grade PMG Ch Unc 64EPQ, 62 with evidence prior mounting, 64 and 65EPQ.\$4195
