1. $\$ 20$ 1864, Fr. 191a, CITN. Of the 61 pieces known, only 4 are graded nicer. Though some restorations are noted by PCGS, this piece does not exhibit any major internal problems caused mainly by the deterioration of the bronzing encountered on mid-grade Compound Interest Notes. This pleasing type is dated Oct. 15, 1864. The Greensheet offers a wholesale price of \$26k in VF 20--we're proud to offer this for considerably less. PCGS VF 30.
